ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 16 JUNE 2024

The iconic words of St. Paul - "we walk by faith and not by sight" - seems to our modern, empirically driven, technology obsessed world, like they are the very antitheses of reason. These words, however, are not a rejection of science and reason, rather they call us to tap into a deeper rationale-indeed the Reason, Logos, Word - which is the




principal that has given expression to all things. That reason is transcendent of our universe and so necessarily exists beyond our sight. It it that 'Logos' that we name as true God.

Brothers and Sisters, we live in a world of constant change: but we are called to adhere to that which is eternal. We live in a word of sensory overload and bombastic distractions: we are called to attend to the One who can be received by faith alone, who so often comes in the guiet stillness of prayer.

As we grapple with this world, and even as we make use of the thing of this world, let us not be absorbed by them. Everything in this world is passing way and that which seems to us to be utterly apparent, solid and worthy of our attention, will turn to dust. Soon enough we will wake from this life, as from a dream, and then we will truly see. Let us fix the eyes of our faith on heavenly glory and, even as we walk amid changing things, let us strive for those things which are eternal. (Cf. 2 Cor 4:18) As we continue on our pilgrim's journey, may we truly "walk by faith and not by sight."


Parish Birthdays

Stop the anti-faith Anti-Discrimination Bill

The Queensland Government have released a draft Anti-Discrimination Bill, that would be the most restrictive regime in Australia for religious freedoms. It would significantly restrict the ability of churches, schools and other faith organisations to choose who we employ, as well as introducing other harsh restrictions. Please see attached the letter to the Premier from the signatory faith organisations of Queensland.

The most important thing you can do is to write to your local MP and tell them you are concerned about the bill.

Politicians won't know that we care about this unless we tell them.


